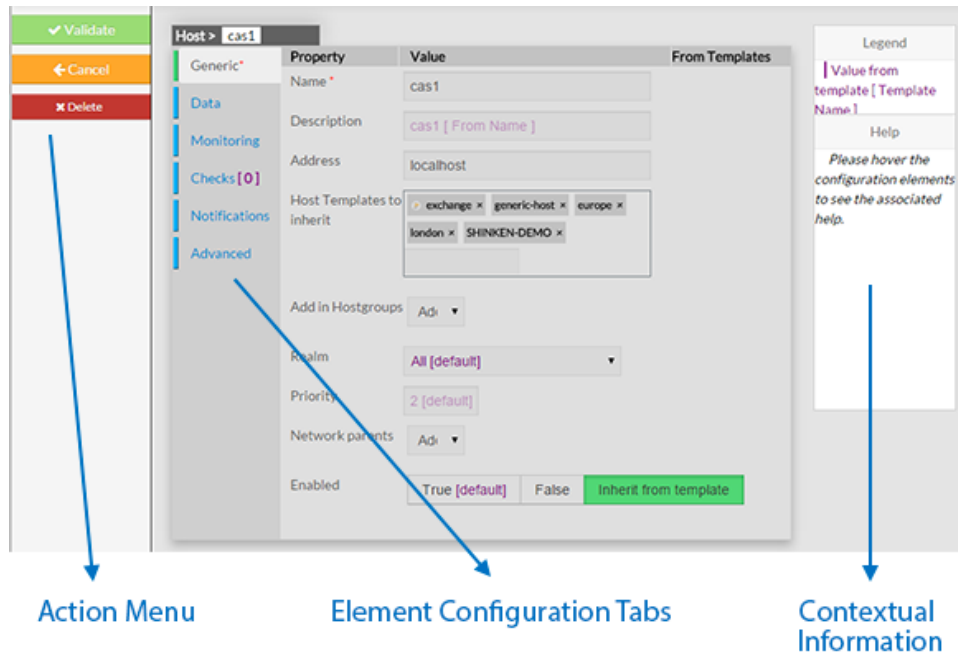


Elements Pages

Layout of the edition page

Every page for elements configuration are organized in the same way.
The Layout is divided in 3 sections :

- Action Menu
- Element Configuration Tabs
 - It contain all information of an element.
- Contextual Information and Help



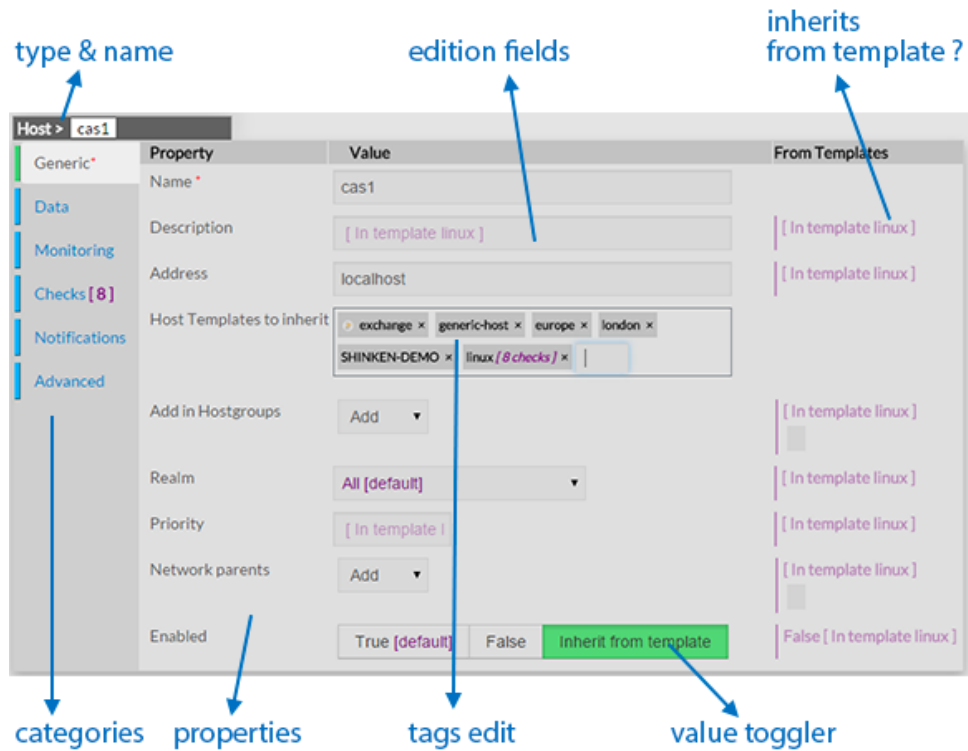
Action Menu

This Menu provides to the Administrator the common actions to Validate, Cancel, or Delete the selected object.

- When validating a configuration, the object will be placed in the list of Changes to Apply.
- If the Administrator click on the Cancel button, every changes made after previous saving, will be lost.
- If the Delete button is clicked, a confirmation popup will be displayed,
 - asking the Administrator to validate or cancel the deletion of object.

Element Configuration Tabs

he type of the element and its name are displayed on the top of the Area.



As they are numerous, elements properties are split by category among tabs.




- Tabs list will be different following the type of the selected element.
- Tab layout is always the same:
 - A list of properties linked to the category
 - A row of this list contains always 3 columns:
 - Name of Property
 - Value of Property
 - Value inherited from template (only for hosts, checks and contact)

Note:

Values displayed in purple are by default value or inherited from a template.

- Values Editing Field can be of different kind:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Dropdown list <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Select int the dropdown list the value you want <p><i>Note: Only one value is possible for this field.</i></p> 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Toggle buttons <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Select one of the 3 possibles values (True, False, Inherit) <p><i>Note: the green one is the one selected.</i></p> 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Horizontal gauge <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Move the cursor up to the expected value. 	

Contextual Informations

This panel is used to help the Administrator, by showing two kind of informations :

- Legend : information to explain the display of the page.
- Contextual Help :
 - Move the mouse on property you want some information
 - The Help Area will contain the description text and some tips for the edition of the property
