Overview

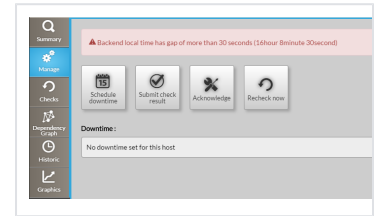
The manage tab is splitted in 2 rows :

- Action buttons
- Scheduled Downtimes (the list of planned downtime)



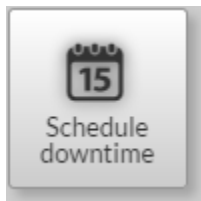
Note: An error could be displayed on the top of this tab if the backend server has a gap of more than 30 seconds with the computer displaying the UI Visualisation portal.

Having a difference between your computer and the server will prevent you to schedule good downtime.

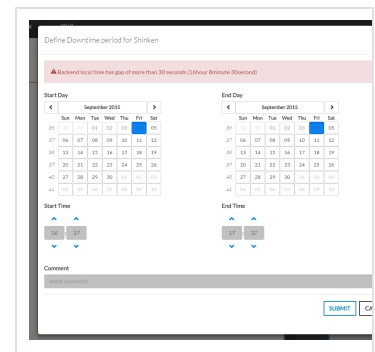


Action buttons

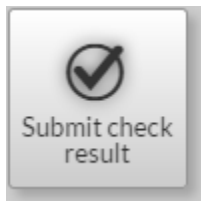
Schedule Downtime button



- It opens a pop-up with two calendars and two selectors for hours.
- You have to define the Start and the End of the downtime period.
- Even if not mandatory, we advise you to add a comment as it will be very usefull for anybody looking at the list of planned downtime.
The purpose of the downtime will be displayed in the list of downtime.



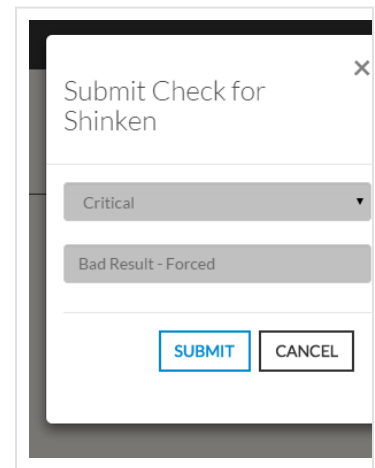
Submit check result button



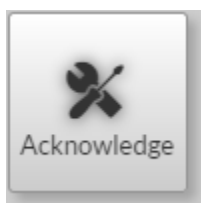
- This button opens a modal form to force the status of the element
