

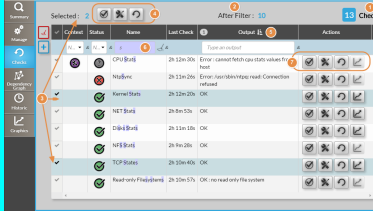
Checks Tab

Overview

The checks tab displays all the checks attached to a host or a cluster.

On the top, the header displays :

- (1) Total Count of checks
- (2) Count of checks after filtering (6)
- (3) Count of selected check rows in the list. On the selection you can perform 3 group actions (4) :
 - Submit a check result (fully described in [Manage Tab](#), Action Buttons)
 - Acknowledge the current status of the check (fully described for Host status in [Hud](#), State Summary : 4)
 - Launch an instant check

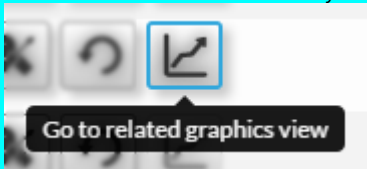

The grid :

- (5) can be sorted (possible multiple sorts)
- (6) can be filtered (possible multiple filters)
- (7) In "Actions" column, 4 buttons are available for each check row.

There are the same 3 actions already available in the header plus a fourth action :
